## 1 Introduction

In mid-2010, Bloomberg announced it would place its system of security identifiers into the public domain, creating the Bloomberg's Open Symbology (BSYM) initiative, a flexible and open system for identifying securities across all global asset classes.

As part of the BSYM initiative, Bloomberg created the Global Identifier (BBGID) available without limitation to store, use or redistribute to market players for research, trading and mapping of more than 85 million active and inactive securities. Bloomberg will continue to update, build and administer the BBGID to ensure their accuracy and effectiveness.

The FIX specification currently supports a SecurityIDSource field (tag 22) with an enumeration value for Bloomberg Symbol (SecurityIDSource = A), which is commonly used for legacy Bloomberg symbols, tickers.

This gap analysis is proposing to add a new value to support the new BSYM identifier for SecurityIDSource(22):

- ~~TBD-S~~ = Bloomberg Open Symbology BBGID  
Bloomberg would like to request the capital letter O as the new enumeration value. (Note, the letter "S" is officially assigned.)
